

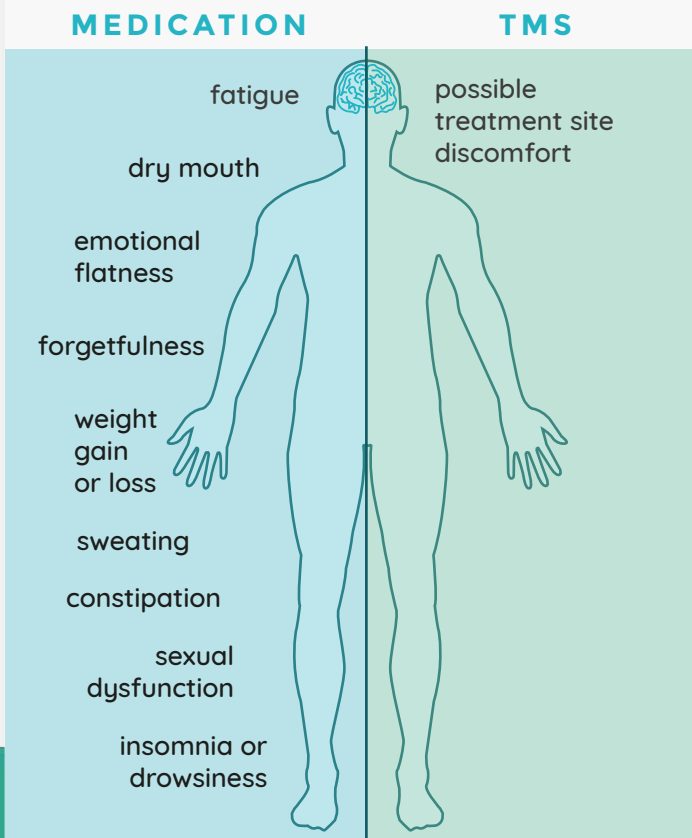

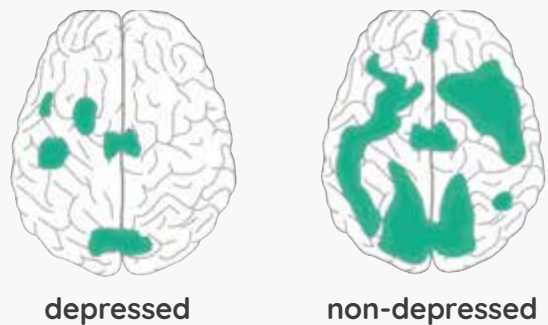
COMMON SIDE EFFECTS

comparing treatments



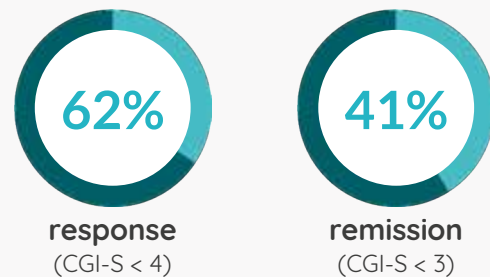
DEPRESSION'S EFFECT

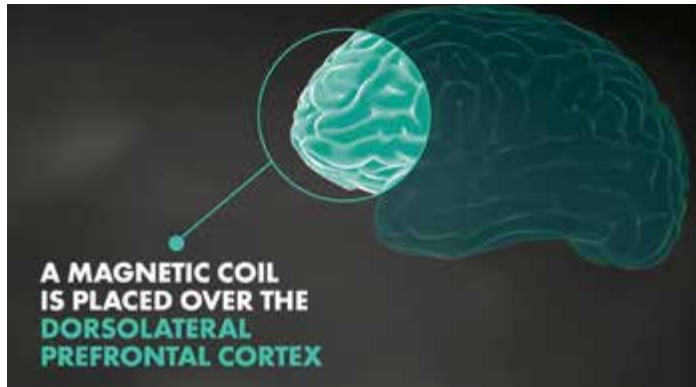
TMS CGI-S RATES

How TMS Works

MECHANISM OF ACTION



- Uses MRI-strength magnetic coil
- Aids neuroplasticity with minimal side effects (scalp sensitivity or mild headaches)
- On average, patients begin to see treatment impact at week 2*
